OUTSTANDING SAFETY EDUCATOR AWARD

The American Society of Safety Engineers' Outstanding Safety Educator Award sponsored by **PPG Industries Inc.** is presented annually in order to recognize exemplary achievements in Safety, Health and Environmental (SHE) Education.

With this award the following objectives are envisioned: 1) provide leadership and support for ASSE student sections; 2) recruit student ASSE members; 3) participate in the ASSE student awards and scholarship programs; 4) demonstrate the importance of SHE research and publication; 5) emphasize the importance of effective SHE instruction; 6) increase educator level of activity in ASSE and set a strong example for students; and 7) reaffirm ASSE's commitment to higher education as the most preferred preparation for the SHE profession.

Award and Presentation

This award carries with it a cash award of \$1500. This award is named for Dr. William E. Tarrants, past ASSE President and Fellow and noted pioneer in Safety Education. Presentation is at the Society's annual Professional Development Conference.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this award, nominees must be actively engaged as a faculty member (assistant professor or above) and in a tenure track in a safety or related program and be a Professional Member of ASSE in good standing for at least the five (5) year period prior to this nomination.

Nominations

Nominations must be submitted to the ASSE Technical and Professional Recognition Committee, 1800 East Oakton, Des Plaines, IL 60018-2187 – postmarked no later than January 10 to be considered that same year. Colleagues (*include Chapters,*

Regional Operating Committees, Practice Specialty Councils, Standing Committees and Board), the immediate supervisor or students of the nominee may submit them

The nominee's entire submission should include the following items:

- The completed **nomination form** and **letter of endorsement** from the **nominating** colleague (*include Chapters, Regional Operating Committees, Practice Specialty Councils, Standing Committees and Board*), immediate supervisor or student. These two items should not exceed 3 pages.
- A **single-page resume** of the nominee's professional background plus a recent black and white head and shoulder's photo (used for public relations purposes only).
- Seven copies of the entire petition must be submitted.

Selection Criteria

Nominees must provide information to show their achievements in each of the four (4) areas below during a five (5) year period of time preceding the date of nomination:

- A. Quality of teaching
- B. Research and publications
- C. ASSE activity
- D. Other university or organizational contributions
- E. ASSE Student Section Support

Submission Deadline

Nomination package plus 6 copies must be received at ASSE by **January 10** and will be considered as complete when received.
