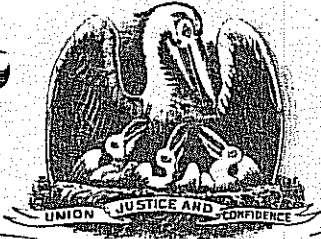

WHEREAS, a total of 942 fatal work injuries were recorded in Louisiana during years 2000 through 2008; and

WHEREAS, each and every employer should continue to emphasize the elimination of recognized workplace hazards; and

WHEREAS, every worker in Louisiana should have a right to safe and healthy workplace; and

WHEREAS, the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 promises American Workers the right to a safe job; and

WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana Occupation Safety and Health Consultation Division supports fully the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bobby Jindal, Governor of the State of Louisiana, do hereby proclaim April 28, 2009 as

WORKERS MEMORIAL DAY
in the State of Louisiana.
