CONGRATULATING THE GREATER BOSTON CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF SAFETY ENGINEERS ON ITS CELEBRATION OF NORTH AMERICAN OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH WEEK AND OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH PROFESSIONAL DAY.

WHEREAS, THE GREATER BOSTON CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF SAFETY ENGINEERS IS CELEBRATING THE WEEK OF MAY 2, 2010, AS NORTH AMERICAN OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH WEEK; AND

WHEREAS, THE GREATER BOSTON CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF SAFETY ENGINEERS IS ALSO CELEBRATING THE DAY OF MAY 5, 2010, AS OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH PROFESSIONAL DAY; AND

WHEREAS, THE GREATER BOSTON CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF SAFETY ENGINEERS ENCOURAGES ITS MEMBERS TO PARTICIPATE IN NORTH AMERICAN OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH WEEK TO INCREASE AWARENESS OF HOW TO PREVENT INJURY AND ILLNESS IN THE WORKPLACE; AND

WHEREAS, THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF SAFETY ENGINEERS WAS FOUNDED IN 1911 AND CURRENTLY HAS 32,000 OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY, HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROFESSIONAL MEMBERS; AND

WHEREAS, EVERYDAY MILLIONS OF PEOPLE GO TO AND RETURN HOME FROM WORK SAFELY DUE TO THE EFFORT OF OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY, HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL PRACTITIONERS WHO INTEGRATE SAFETY INTO THE WORKPLACE; AND

WHEREAS, THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF SAFETY ENGINEERS HAS LONG RECOGNIZED THAT A SAFER WORKPLACE POSITIVELY IMPACTS EMPLOYEE PRODUCTIVITY AND SATISFACTION AND EMPHASIZED THE IMPORTANCE OF DECREASING WORKPLACE INJURIES AND DEATHS; AND

WHEREAS, IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT EMPLOYERS, EMPLOYEES AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC ARE AWARE OF THE IMPORTANCE OF PREVENTING ILLNESS AND INJURY IN THE WORKPLACE AND OF THE POSITIVE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF INTEGRATING EFFECTIVE SAFETY AND HEALTH PROGRAMS IN THE WORKPLACE; NOW THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, THAT THE MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL COURT HEREBY CONGRATULATES THE GREATER BOSTON CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF THE SAFETY ENGINEERS ON ITS CELEBRATION OF NORTH AMERICAN OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH WEEK AND OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH PROFESSIONAL DAY; AND BE IT FURTHER
