

## Reference Format for *Professional Safety*

*Professional Safety* follows APA style for reference documentation. Refer to *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association* or visit [www.apastyle.org](http://www.apastyle.org) for additional guidance. Whether paraphrasing or quoting an author directly, you must credit the source in the text by providing the author's last name and year of publication. For direct quotes, include a specific page citation as well. Samples of common citations are highlighted here.
